### Two tests scheduled by Fairways Exploration in eastern Conecuh County

Houston-based Fairways Exploration & Production LLC has permitted two directional tests in the eastern portion of Alabama's Conecuh County, adding to an extensive Smackover drilling program.

Located two and one-quarter miles west of the Covington County line in the se nw se 12-5n-13e is the 1 Sanders "12-16" (API 01-035-20220). Proposed total depth is 10,600 ft with an expected bottomhole to the southeast beneath the same section.

About a mile to the southwest, in the se nw ne 14-5n-13e, is the operator's 1 Morgan "14-8" (API 01-035-20219). It is expected to reach a total depth of 10,950 ft and bottom to the southeast beneath the same section.

Fairways has drilled another directional test about a half mile east of that location. Its 1 Morgan "13-5" (API 01-035-20216) reached a total depth of 10,425 ft and was production tested through perforations at 10,166-10,197 ft last month. Five-and-a-half-inch casing is set five ft off the bottom.

Production is another three-quarters of a mile to the southwest in the ne sw se 14-5n-13e. Midroc Operating Co completed the 23-2 Cedar Creek Land & Timber in August 2010 flowing 210 bbls of 48-degree oil and 203,000 cu ft of gas daily through acid-treated perforations at 10,420-10,440 ft in the Smackover. The 10,635-ft wildcat has yet to be brought online.

The Midroc well is located on the northeastern flank of Little Cedar Creek field, a Smackover oil pool.

Midroc and Sklar Exploration Co are active at several tests in the vicinity.
