

Production Pipe Run By Sklar In Conecuh Near Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., Ltd., Shreveport, La., has run production casing at a Smackover wildcat near Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Craft-Ralls 5-10, NW SE Section 5-4N-13E, was drilled to a depth of 11,200 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,200 feet for completion.

Location of the well is slightly over one-half mile easterly from production at Little Cedar Creek Field.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

The well is located on a 160-acre unit which includes the southeast quarter of Section 5.

Slightly over one-half mile northwest of the current wildcat, Sklar recently completed No. 1 Craft-Cedar Creek Land & Timber, Inc. 5-5, SW NW Section 5-4N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well pumped 95 barrels 40-gravity oil per day.

Completion was from pay in Smackover through perforations 10,960-970 feet. Total depth is 11,200 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 11,193 feet.

Sklar has been active in the development of the east-northeast portion of the field. About three-quarters of a mile southwest of the current test, Sklar completed No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 130 barrels 43-gravity oil and 210,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 145 pounds.

Completion was from perforations in Smackover between 11,133 and 11,207 feet. Total depth is 11,515 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.
