

# Sklar Runs Production Casing At Smackover Test In Conecuh

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has logged pay in Smackover and run production casing at a well on north flank of a southerly extension area to Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

The No. 1 Ralls 30-8, SE NE Section 30-4N-13E, was drilled to a depth of 11,780 feet. Shows were logged in Smackover and string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., handled contract for drilling.

Location of the potential producer is one and one-quarter miles northwest of Brooklyn.

At south offset to the current well, Midroc Operating Co. recently completed the No. 30-15 Mary Mark, SW SE Section 29-4N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 420 barrels 48-gravity oil and 42,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 10/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 900 pounds. Gas-Oil ratio was 1016 to one.

Completion was from pay in Smackover from perforations 11,574-595 feet.

Drilled to a depth of 12,000 feet, string of 5 1/2-inch casing was run to total depth for completion in Smackover.
