

Sklar Near Contract At Smackover Test In Little Cedar Ck. Area

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., is nearing proposed depth at a Smackover wildcat one-half mile east of Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Drilling is proceeding below 11,216 feet at No. 1 Craft-Mack 8-2, NW NE Section 8-4N-13E.

Rapad Drilling Co., Jackson, Miss., is handling contract for the proposed 11,600-foot test.

Site of the wildcat is two miles west-northwest of Paul.

One-half mile west of the test, Sklar completed No. 1 Craft-Brye 8-4, NW NW Section 8-4N-13E. A Smackover completion, the well flowed 130 barrels 43-gravity oil and 210,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 20/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 145 pounds.

Completion was from perforations in Smackover between 11,133 and 11,207 feet.

Total depth is 11,515 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom.
