

Sklar To Drill Test On Northern Flank Of Little Cedar Ck.

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has selected site for a Smackover test north of production at Little Cedar Creek Field in southern Alabama's Conecuh County.

Moving one-half mile north of production, location was surveyed for No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-7, SW NE Section 33-5N-13E.

Rapad Drilling & Well Service, Inc., Jackson, Miss., will handle contract for the 10,950-foot Smackover test.

Location is on a 160-acre unit including the northeast quarter of Section 33.

One-half mile south-southwest of the latest location, Sklar earlier drilled the No. 1 Craft-Ralls 33-14, SE SW Section 33-5N-13E.

A Smackover completion, the well flowed 395 barrels 40-gravity oil and 382,000 cubic feet of gas per day through a 17/64-inch choke with flowing tubing pressure 440 pounds.

Production is from pay in Smackover from perforations 10,928-956 feet. Total depth is 11,100 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to bottom for completion.
