

Sklar wildcats yield ~500 boepd in Smackover Formation

Privately-held Sklar Exploration completed three directional wildcat wells in the Smackover Formation within Escambia Co., AL with an average IP rate of 501 boepd (86% oil).

The Cedar Creek Land & Timber 9-8 #1 well

tested the highest with an IP of 560 boepd and 345 Mcfd, or 618 boepd (91% oil), with 1,200 psi FTP after being drilled to 12,440 ft MD (12,417 ft TVD). The last two wells, the Cedar Creek Land & Timber 10-5 #1 and 24-1 #1, tested at 414 boepd and 337 Mcfd (470 boepd), and 332 boepd and 493



Mcfid (414 boepd), after being drilled to an MD of 12,410 ft and 13,380 ft, respectively. Shreveport-based Sklar is currently operating one vertical rig in Covington and Escambia Cos., AL drilling the Smackover. The company also filed one wildcat permit targeting the Smackover in Escambia Co. which has yet to be drilled.

Sklar is an affiliated operating company of Sklarco LLC and is managed by Howard F. Sklar with offices in Shreveport, LA and Boulder, CO. According to DrillingInfo, the company is producing 4,109 boepd and 5,569 Mcfd from ~45 wells in Alabama.
