

Sklar Spuds Wildcat Near Latham Field In Baldwin County

Sklar Exploration Co., LLC, Shreveport, La., has spudded a Paluxy wildcat one and one-quarter miles southwest of Latham in southwestern Alabama's Baldwin County.

The company is logging at 9200 feet at No. 1 Nelson et al 35 in irregular Section 35-2N-2E.

Drill-site is one-quarter mile northeast of the discovery well for Latham Field.

D & D Drilling & Exploration, Inc., Ferriday, La., is handling contract for the 9200-foot test.

One-quarter mile southwest of the current well, Pruet Production Co. drilled No. 1-Nelson-Reynolds 35, Section 35-2N-2E, discovery well for Latham Field.

Productive from Washita-Fredericksburg, the discovery pumped 186 barrels 28-gravity oil and four barrels water per day.

Completion was from perforations 8046-50 feet in Washita-Fredericksburg. Total depth is 9636 feet and 5 1/2-inch casing was run to 9634 feet for completion.

Elevation was 129 feet, derrick floor. Top of Chalk was logged at 3920 feet, Base Chalk 5150, Lower Tuscaloosa 6280, Washita-Fredericksburg 7676, Ladner Sand 8046, Paluxy 8450 and Mooringsport 9506 feet.
