Title: Union County test permitted by Sklar Exploration

In the southwestern portion of Union County, Arkansas, Shreveport-based **Sklar** Exploration Co LLC has scheduled an exploratory test almost three miles north of North Louisiana's Claiborne County line. Plans call for the 1 M. L. Norrell (API 03-139-13055) to reach a total depth of 7800 ft in the sw sw nw 19-19s-16w.

Almost one-half mile to the east-southeast is another **Sklar** test. The 1 Rogers (API 03-139-13042), ne ne sw of the same section, reached a total depth of 7760 ft in the Cotton Valley. It is cased to 7757 ft with 5 1/2-inch pipe.

The new location is over three quarters of a mile west-northwest of an 8150-ft well also completed by **Sklar** Exploration. Located in the nw ne se of the same section, the 1 Cameron has yielded a cumulative 250,000 cu ft of gas and 76,748 bbls of condensate from the Cotton Valley at 7551-58 ft since being brought online in 2003. The well opened Laney Road field and remains the only producer in the reservoir.

The 1 Cameron immediately offsets another **Sklar** venture. The 2 Cameron was completed in March 2004, also in Laney Road field, and was drilled to a total depth of 8150 ft. The well was tested flowing 9.68 million cu ft of gas and 286.4 bbls of condensate per day through perforations at 7634-44 ft in the Cotton Valley. It has yet to be brought online.
