

# Sklar sets production casing at western Bienville Parish test

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Sklar Exploration is waiting on completion tools at a western Bienville Parish venture that could potentially expand Sailes field to the northwest.

The 1 Pavillion Land Development LLC (API 17-013-22138) was drilled to a total depth of 7007 ft, with five-inch casing set on bottom. The anticipated Pettet producer was drilled from a site in the se nw nw of section 9-16n-8w.

Offsetting the 1 Pavillion to the east is the 1 Martin Timber Co, a deeper Cotton Valley venture abandoned in 1991 at a total depth of 12,345 ft. Also nearby is the 1 Lawhon "9," which was abandoned in 1998 at a total depth of 9900 ft in the Hosston.

Numerous Sailes field wells are in the area just over a mile and a half southeast of Sklar's anticipated producer. Since coming online in 1945, the reservoir has yielded 1.6 million bbls of crude/condensate, 269 billion cu ft of gas and 7.1 million bbls of water. Through October, reservoir output in 2013 is 16,391 bbls of crude/condensate, 2.6 billion cu ft of gas and 181,272 bbls of water. Production comes from perforations in the Pettet at 6670-6950 ft and deeper Hosston at 7035-10,550 ft. Field production in recent years has come from more than 170 active wells. ConocoPhillips and Energen Resources operate most of the wells in the long-producing field.

To the south is production in Jamestown and Lake Bistaneau fields.
